## #2 - Get Organized

### Organize Local Teams

Team Leaders, Data Person, Promoter, Recruiter, Researcher, Strategist

### Get Coaching from Others

Leverage the experience of others.

## #3 – Implement the Plan

Team Leaders – Manage work, Organize regular meetings, National meetings,  
Communication

“No Drama”

“Keep the main thing the main thing.” – Jon Matthews

“Start Small”

Data Person – Obtain election data, Employ data tools, Explore strategies

Promoter – Select dates, Obtain venues, Speakers

Recruiter – Organize patriot groups, grassroots networking, Engage churches,  
Form coalitions, Rekindle patriotism in churches (Black Robe Regiment)

Researcher – Evaluate Sheriff, Election Officials, County Supervisors, Research  
Policies and Laws

Strategist – Political strategies, Security, Red Team

## #4 – Do the Work

Team Leaders – Meet with Sheriff, Election Officials, County Supervisors

“Show them their future” - Dr Frank

Continue Training – National Network Calls, Consult with Resources

Data – Data analysis, test canvassing, (two pairs door knocking)

Event Promotion and Planning – all media types, make arrangements

Research – Death Records, Ancestry.com

Strategist – Red Team – Behavior above reproach

## #5 – Build the Movement

Hold regular meetings, Invite local officials, private meetings before and after

Collect Data - door knocking, digital research, collect affidavits

Create Public Awareness – Local media, Picketing, Marches, Prayer Meetings

Network With National Efforts – Grassroots, Encouragement, Empowerment

“Movements Are About Relationships”

## #6 – Review Progress

Review evidence, Proof affidavits, Additional Research

Organize Data, Prepare Documentation, Public Strategy, County Officials, Public  
Meetings

Plan Legal Strategy – Sheriff Validation, District Attorney

Fraud cases must be unassailable - Proof with Experts

## #7 – Local Empowerment

Validation by Election Officials and Sheriff

Public Awareness (Supervisors' meetings)
